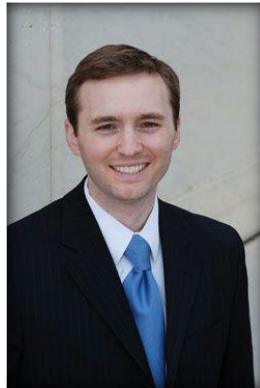
The title of the launch lecture is:
